

## 2 | Utility Introduction

Beyond the original and amazing artwork, Crypto Fishing Club offers creative and competitive utility with its NFTs. Our approach allows FisherFreak owners who have skin in the game to stack more crypto in two ways: via winning poker tournaments and staking poker players.

### **I. Play2Win**

Use your FisherFreaks to play in the club's poker game for the opportunity to win \$SOL and high-quality NFTs.

### **II. Stake2Earn**

Cev1che is a six-year live poker cash game professional who currently plays high-stakes No Limit Hold 'Em and 5-card Pot Limit Omaha at MGM National Harbor Casino. He is the club's horse who will be providing value/sweat equity for the community. Stake the rarest FisherFreak Type (i.e. Predator) to get a piece of Cev1che's action.

## 3 | \$CHIP

Crypto Fishing Club's poker game unit for tournament buy-ins is called \$CHIP (not a cryptocurrency). There is no other cost to play (your crypto is not at risk).

How is \$CHIP acquired?

### 1. FisherFreak Ownership

Each FisherFreak is valued at exactly 100 \$CHIP. If you own one FisherFreak, 100 \$CHIP is automatically added to your \$CHIP balance.

This scales linearly; that is,

$$\text{\$CHIP balance} = (\text{\# of FisherFreaks in wallet}) * 100$$

For example, 3 FisherFreaks in wallet = 300 \$CHIP balance

### 2. Dice Roll (optional)

Each FisherFreak is eligible to execute one Dice Roll per week. The cost is 100 \$CHIP. There are two possible results: win 100 \$CHIP or lose 100 \$CHIP.

Choose a FisherFreak to roll two six-sided dice (via our Discord bot). Let's define the first die as D1 and the second die as D2.

The FisherFreak rolling the dice, D1 and D2, is the Shooter. The Shooter's Type corresponds to its Luckiness (Luckiness increases as Type rarity increases).

Luckiness is defined as a multiplier, L.

The final number of the Dice Roll is defined as

$$\text{ROLL} = (D1 + D2) * L$$

Now, we need to determine how to apply ROLL to the overall result of the Dice Roll (win \$100 CHIP or lose 100 \$CHIP).

The Critical ROLL (C\_ROLL) is defined as the ROLL number that differentiates between a successful ROLL (S\_ROLL) and a failed ROLL (F\_ROLL).

Successful ROLL is defined as  $S\_ROLL = ROLL \geq C\_ROLL$

Failed ROLL is defined as  $F\_ROLL = ROLL < C\_ROLL$

The Critical ROLL is set to 10,

$C\_ROLL = 10$

A successful ROLL is now:

$S\_ROLL = ROLL \geq 10$

The result of a successful ROLL is a 100 \$CHIP win (200 \$CHIP is returned)

A failed ROLL is now:

$F\_ROLL = ROLL < 10$

The result of a failed ROLL is a 100 \$CHIP loss (0 \$CHIP is returned)

### Dice ROLL Table

Note the positive correlation between Shooter's Type Rarity and Luckiness L.

Therefore, the rarer the Shooter Type, the better chance of a successful ROLL to win 100 \$CHIP.

For example, FisherFreak #0008 is Type: Dali → Rarity: Common → L = 1.

This shooter must roll (D1+D2) a 10, 11, or 12 (16.7% chance) to win 100 \$CHIP; otherwise, he loses 100 \$CHIP.



## 4 | Starting Stack Size

Select one FisherFreak to be used as your tournament entry (FF\_ENTRY). This FisherFreak must have BOTH a Status (other than “None”) AND a Strategy (other than “None”) to be eligible for tournament entry!

FF\_ENTRY’s traits determine your Starting Stack Size (SSS) for the tournament.

### 1. Status (“Bankroll”)

FF\_ENTRY’s Status corresponds to a constant called Bankroll (BR) measured in big blinds.

### 2. Strategy (“Skill Level”)

FF\_ENTRY’s Strategy corresponds to a multiplier called Skill Level (SL).

The Starting Stack Size (in big blinds) is the product of FF\_ENTRY’s Bankroll and Skill Level:

$$SSS = BR * SL$$

### Starting Stack Size Table

The estimated distribution of FisherFreaks that have both a Status and a Strategy is ~43% (~430/1000). Therefore, ~43% of FisherFreaks are eligible to be used for tournament entry while ~57% are not.

As seen in the table, a Status: “None” has a Bankroll of 0 and Strategy: “None” has a Skill Level of 0. Therefore, Starting Stack Size ( $SSS = BR * SL$ ) is 0 if Bankroll is 0 and/or Skill Level is 0 (hence, the tournament entry eligibility requirement).

For example,

FisherFreak #0001 has Status: “Moon Boi” and Strategy: “Ape”

Therefore,  $SSS = 20 * 1 = 20$  big blinds

→If you select FisherFreak #0001 as your FF\_ENTRY, you would start the tournament with 20 big blinds.

FisherFreak #0002 has Status: “Moon Boi” and Strategy: “None”

Therefore,  $SSS = 20 * 0 = 0$  Big Blinds

→FisherFreak #0002 would not be eligible for tournament entry!

# 5 | FisherFreaks Poker Open

Our first tournament series is the FisherFreaks Poker Open (FFPO). All FFPO events run throughout the minting period of the entire 1,000 FisherFreaks collection. Non-FFPO tournaments may run throughout the series as well. Poker tournament play is standard (other than starting stack sizes).

## Tournament Schedule

**Start:** FFPO Event #1 starts when ~10% (~100/1000) of FisherFreaks are sold/distributed

**Date/Time:** Sunday nights, Eastern Time Zone

### Entry Requirements:

- One eligible FisherFreak (FF\_ENTRY)
- Sufficient \$CHIP balance for Buy-In

**Registration:** Discord

**Site:** pokernow.club (no account/download needed; mobile-friendly)

**Prizes:** \$SOL | FisherFreaks

**\$CHIP Balance:** Each FisherFreak's \$CHIP value resets to 100 after each tournament

## 6 | Potomac Winter Poker Open

Cev1che is going to run the Potomac Winter Poker Open (PWPO) gauntlet to provide value/sweat equity for the community (including the \$3k buy-in/\$500k guarantee main event).

Stake the rarest FisherFreak Type (i.e. Predator) to get a piece of Cev1che's action. That is, own 1 of the 3 legendary Predators to have equity in Cev1che's PWPO winnings! Note that none of Predators will not be listed; they can only be won in the final 3 FFPO events.

# 7 | Live Cash Games

Cev1che specializes in live cash games.

Standard game choices at MGM National Harbor Casino include:

- 5/10+ NLHE
- 5/5/15+ 5-card PLO

At his discretion, Cev1che will distribute a percentage of a randomly chosen cash game session's winnings to:

- CFC's poker tournament prize pools
- Owners of Rare/Legendary FisherFreak Types (i.e. Basquiat/Predator)

## 8 | Future Ideas

### Play2Win

- adjust trait stats to optimize gameplay
- integrate next collection, *Bait & Tackle*, into gameplay
- use Treasury funds to farm more crypto for prize pools

### Stake2Earn

- hire developer to implement smart contracts for staking
- more structured staking design for cash games
- more horses added to the stable
- player prop bets e.g. tournament last longer bet
- hand history reviews for exclusive holders (e.g. Basquiat/Predator owners)
